**Forms:** Must be completed and signed and fees paid in full before members will be insured and teams are able to begin practice.

**Safety Requirements:** All coaches must submit online a valid CPR and First Aid Certification and CA Driver's License. The Driver's License is required so that we may do a background check. A copy of each Student Membership/Waiver Form must be onsite at all club/team activities.

**Contests:** The regular season consists of 5 contests (weather permitting).

- **High School** competitions will start with a team versus team format. Individual competition will follow immediately. Team and individual rankings will be maintained throughout the season.
- **Middle School** competitions will use an individual advancement format. Team and individual rankings will be maintained throughout the season.
- **Trophies and/or Medals** will be presented to teams and individuals at the end of each regular season contest and at the End-of-Season.
- **State Championships** is a separate event from the regular season contests and is by invitation only for the top teams in the league. See the Contest Schedule on our webpage for dates.

**Insurance:**

- \$10,000 Secondary Accident Policy for all participants
- \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance for Bodily Injury or Property Damage.
- Injury Report Form must be submitted for any injury requiring medical attention.

### Eligibility of Competitors

- SSS is designed for a school-based surf team league.
- Members of a team must be enrolled full-time at the school for which they surf.
- Members enrolled full-time in Charter Schools or other California state-approved programs may surf for their school of residence (that which they would attend according to school district and home address) and must adhere to that school district's policy.
- If there is not a team at your school of residence then you can choose another school in your school district in accordance with district/school athletic policy. Please call the office for clarification if needed.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA to compete in SSS competitions.
- Shortboards 7'6" and under. Longboards 9' or 3' over surfers head.
- All required forms and membership fees are received by SSS.

### Eligibility of Teams

- High School Teams are grades 9-12. Middle School Teams are grades 6-8.
- All coaches must submit a copy of CPR/ First Aid certification and Driver's License.
- All required forms submitted online and fees paid to the SSS office.
- Two schools may combine as one team (subject to annual approval of SSS) if:
  1. One is an all boys' school and the other is an all girls' school.
  2. Special circumstances such as school size are an obstacle in forming a team.
