By Sept 17 confirm your team's participation by email for a guaranteed spot. After that it will be on a first-come, first-served basis for remaining spots. Late entries will be accepted until full.

Deadline for Forms AND Fees is Sept 24 for divisions SDMS 1, SDMS 2 and Ventura-Morro Bay only

Deadline for Forms AND Fees is Oct 1 for all other divisions.

Forms must be submitted online and fees paid in full before members will be insured and teams can begin practice. The final due dates are stated above. There are two forms you will find on our website:

- Student Registration Form - one for each surfer (Membership and Waiver)

Fees/Donations: There are **TWO** fees due. No refunds after the deadline date.

Safety Requirements: Coaches must submit Team Registration Form online.

- Valid CPR and/or First Aid Certification
- Background check. You will find the link at the bottom of the Team Registration form.
**Background checks should be submitted by all coaches and volunteers who will lead any team activity on their own. In other words any team activity should have at least one person who has a completed background check.
- We strongly recommend a hard copy of each Student Registration (Membership/Waiver) Form be onsite at all club/team activities in case there is no cell phone reception.

Contests: The regular season consists of 5 contests (weather permitting).

- **Schedule** is available online today at www.surfSSS.org
- **High School** competitions will start with a team versus team format. Individual competition will follow immediately. Team and individual rankings will be maintained throughout the season.
- **Middle School** competitions will use an individual advancement format. Team and individual rankings will be maintained throughout the season.
- **Trophies and/or Medals** will be presented to teams and individuals at the end of each regular season contest and at the End-of-Season.
- **State Championships** is a separate event and fee from the regular season contests. It is by invitation only for the top teams in the SSS league as well as other California Surf Leagues. See the Contest Schedule on our webpage for State Champ dates.

Eligibility of Competitors

- SSS is designed for a school-based surf team league.
- Members of a team must be enrolled full-time at the school for which they surf.
- Members enrolled full-time in Charter Schools or other California state-approved programs may surf for their school of residence (that which they would attend according to school district and home address) and must adhere to that school district's policy.
- If there is not a team at your school of residence then you can choose another school in your school district in accordance with district/school athletic policy. Call the office for approval.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA to compete in SSS competitions.
- Shortboards 7'6" and under. Longboards 9' or 3' over surfers head.
- All required forms and membership fees are received by SSS.

Eligibility of Teams

- High School Teams are grades 9-12. Middle School Teams are grades 6-8.
- All coaches must submit a copy of CPR/ First Aid certification and Driver's License.
- All required forms submitted online and fees paid to the SSS office.
- Two schools may combine as one team (subject to annual approval of SSS) if:
 1. One is an all boys' school and the other is an all girls' school.
 2. Special circumstances such as school size are an obstacle in forming a team.

Insurance:

- \$10,000 Secondary Accident Policy for all participants
- Coaching Staff who submit Team Registration forms are automatically covered.
